

Sid: My guest saw healings. But after God made a course adjustment in his life, he now sees major miracles. I mean, over 80 percent are getting healed. And he wants to help you make that same course adjustment. Isn't it time? Next on this edition of It's Supernatural.

Can ancient secrets of the supernatural be rediscovered? Do angels exist? Is there life after death? Are healing miracles real? Can you get supernatural help from another dimension? Has the future been written in advance? Sid Roth has spent 30 years researching the strange world of the supernatural. Join Sid on this edition of It's Supernatural.

Sid: Hello. Sid Roth. Welcome to my world where it's naturally supernatural. My guest, Brian Adams, was on a 40-day fast and he heard from God. As a result of what he heard, he made a course redirection, and as a result of this, he has opened up his hearing from God, his ability to pray for the sick, and so many other realms. You wouldn't think one little revelation would do this. I mean, he used to pray for the sick, and he would have maybe 30 percent healed. Now he has over 80 percent healed. But it's not just for healing, it's for everything. And I have never seen someone take a short revelation from God and expand it to every arena of life. Brian, what did God speak to you that changed your life forever?

Brian: I was finishing up a fast, and I was in prayer one day, Sid, and the Spirit of God spoke to me so gentle and just so quietly. He said, "Faith moves me, son, but forgiveness releases my power." And that's what we're looking for, for the power of God, because we as humans are powerless apart from Him. So as He releases His power, I begin to experiment in the prayer lines in trying to continue to ask God, show me more, Father. Show me about what you want me to do. And as he began to show me that faith releases power, He took me to some scriptures that talked about where people refused to forgive they would have tormenting spirits released against them, and then I knew, a scripture came to me, and I heard this in my spirit, that fear has torment. And all of a sudden, I started thinking, fear, now that's phobias. That's anxiety attacks, different things that a lot of times doctors can't heal, and these were tormentings. I began to put, asking the people to pray and release people, forgive them, and just make a conscious decision. Prayer is actually what I call it. They would pray these prayers. We would see them free from anxiety, from phobias, from fibromyalgia, just different things from mental to physical, to even soul issues.

Sid: Wow. Speaking of phobias, severe phobias, tell me about this woman that had this severe phobia that was confined to her house.

Brian: Sid, that was awesome to see God do that. What happened was this lady had been married. Her husband was an abuser, and I mean, not just small stuff, but he would rape her, he'd beat her, keep her locked up inside the house and alienate her from her family. And there's so much of that going on. So she began to hate him, of course like probably anybody would, and when she started hating and having this unforgiveness, the tormenting spirits of insanity and depression, and all this came upon her. Well he eventually left by the law making him leave. She lost her job, she lost her drivers license started having seizures, all these different problems. She would not leave the house, Sid. I mean, it had been two years she had not even left her house. The only time she did was when her mother or sister would come to take her to the doctor quarterly. She'd shut her eyes as tight as she could. They'd put her in the car, leaving her eyes

closed, they'd take her, she'd get inside, the doctor would shut the door, she would then open them. And so this doctor that was treating her was a believer. He said, "I believe that you can do her more good than what I'm doing her." Gave me her phone number, and I called and I went to visit her.

Sid: Okay. So Brian took this revelation and went to visit her. Let's take a look at what happened.

Dave: Hello.

Brian: Hey.

Dave: Pastor Brian.

Brian: Hey, Dr. Dave.

Dave: Listen, I have this patient. She hasn't been out of her house for almost two years. She's been in and out of mental institutions about six times, and well her husband, he beat her, he raped her and he abused her.

Brian: No.

Dave: I figured that you can help her more than I can.

Woman: Please help yourself.

Brian: These are really good. Thank you. Did you make them yourself?

Woman: No, my sister. I used to bake. I used to a lot of things.

Brian: Can you tell us a little bit what's been going on.

Woman: I don't really know where to start.

Brian: Well we're here to help, not judge. So where did it begin?

Woman: Well he seemed like a really great guy. He swept me off my feet. He was always there with roses. And I was in the emergency room maybe ten times last year. My panic would get so bad that I wouldn't leave the house for days and weeks, and then months. I couldn't, I can't do anything.

Brian: You know what? As bad as it is, God wants you to forgive. I know it's not easy and real forgiveness never is. This is the beginning of your healing.

Woman: [crying] Please help me.

Brian: I call this the conscious decision prayer. Okay. And I want you to declare this out loud for me. I trust in Jesus the Messiah.

Woman: I trust in Jesus the Messiah.

Brian: I choose to forgive my husband for beating me.

Woman: I choose to forgive my husband for beating me.

Brian: I choose to forgive my husband for putting me in the hospital. And I command you to come out in the name of Jesus. Faith moves God, but forgiveness releases His power. We were taught in 1 John 4:18 that in love there is no fear. Torment does not exist, but God's complete and perfect love expels every trace of terror.

We'll be right back to It's Supernatural.

We now return to It's Supernatural.

Sid: Hello. Sid Roth here with Brian Adams. Brian heard one sentence from God. It changed his life and everyone's he connected with forever. And God has been expanding this Word and expanding it that has made such a dramatic change in his life. What change has it made in your life, Brian?

Brian: In my life personally, Sid, I remember the scripture as when God gave me this revelation: Faith moves God, but forgiveness releases His power. One of the scriptures that always stays in my heart is, "You must first have brought your own self to obedience before you can bring others." So I knew that before I could teach or preach this revelation that God wanted me to walk it out myself. So when I would get in my private time, my prayer time, and I would just want to spend time alone with God and talk to Him, I began to say, "Holy Spirit, please show me where I have some unforgiveness." And remarkably enough, He'd begin to bring to my remembrance two or three at a time, and I would begin to release these people. Some of them, Sid, I even had to go back and communicate with them and repent, and say I'm sorry, and get these issues. And as I did, I started noticing I could hear from God better. The power of God would begin to flow through me, just preaching everything. I'd always learned that Christ had died for us and that the healing power of God was available for us. So I started saying, I don't think God wants me to get sick, get healed, get sick, get healed. He wants me to walk in Divine health. So using the Word and quoting the Scripture, I just began to do this. But now it was a fight and a battle. But once I got this revelation, it's just almost like you become like Teflon where sickness is repelled and it can't stick to you because now you're walking one with the Father in Heaven, because when He looked out on the planet and He saw it was a mess after Adam sinned, He said, how am I gonna fix this? He said, I'm going to release forgiveness, which begins to take care of the problem that was here on the planet.

Sid: But it's not just sickness.

Brian: No.

Sid: It's every arena.

Brian: Yes.

Sid: Okay. Tell me about the person that had polio.

Brian: This was just recently. I was preaching down in Texas, and God had me teaching on the message of the power of forgiveness, forgiving from the cross, different aspects of the revelation He showed me. The prayer line, people just came flooding up, because Sid, so many people have this bitterness and unforgiveness in their hearts where they had been done wrong. And as the people came up I noticed this one boy, he had on metal braces on his arms and with the canes. He would drag his legs. He could not even pick them up. When I got to him in the prayer line, I said, "Son, what is it that you want from God?" He said, "Sir, I've got cerebral palsy," and he says, "It's too much for me to bear. I'm just a teenager." And he collapsed in my arms weeping and crying. And I said, "Pray this prayer with me." And he had unforgiveness toward God and he actually was mad at God and mad at his parents, 'cause he said, "You guys brought me into this Earth and this is what life has given me." Well I said, "You have to forgive them. It will begin your healing." He said okay. He prayed with me, Sid. Forgave God, forgave his parents and anybody else. And when I prayed for him the power of God came on him and he was released. He went down under the power. He was laying there weeping and crying, prayed for a few more people, came back, we got him up, and he began to walk. Remember, he had to drag his legs. Now he's lifting his knees, and God's Holy Spirit was flowing through him, and he ended up walking all by himself. At the end of the service, he brought up an offering saying, "I want to bless God and thank Him for restoring my life."

Sid: But you know what? Brian is seeing amazing creative miracles. For instance, tell me about the person that had his whole ear removed, inner ear removed.

Brian: Yes. We were having what was called a citywide church meeting. Three or four churches had come together. We began preaching the services, the Word was going forth, the worship was done. We called for the prayer line. A gentleman came up in the prayer line, Sid, and when I saw him, you know, you can tell when someone is excited. I'm like, this guy's got faith, for whatever it is. He was kind of dumping around and excited. And as I went to him, I said, "What can I do for you, sir?" He says, "God spoke to me, Pastor Brian. He's gonna heal me today." "What's the problem?" He said, "Twelve years ago I got an infection in my ear." He said, "It became so bad they surgically removed the anvil, the stirrup, the eardrum, took everything, removed it." They actually took some fat from his side and put it inside there. He had nothing to hear with, and he was totally deaf. He said, "I believe." And so I said, "Well according to your faith," and I put my finger in his ear and prayed for him. Nothing happened. I said, "Well at first if you don't succeed try, try again." I put my finger in there again, and Sid, nothing happened. I'm beginning to sweat now. The line is getting longer for more people. I prayed one more time. Nothing happened. I said, "I'm going to have to go to these other people." And I said, "You stand there and worship God. You've got the Word, now believe." As I started to go off a couple of other people got healed, the Holy Spirit spoke to me, Sid, and said, "He has unforgiveness." I went back to him. I said, "Sir, the Spirit of the Lord just spoke to me and said you have unforgiveness and bitterness in your heart." Now he immediately, when God's presence was there to bring to his

remembrance, he fell on his knees and began saying, "I hate my old pastor. He hurt me. He belittled me." And he began to weep. And I said, I took his hands and said, "Come on. Let's forgive and release him." And when I did, you just see his countenance change. I said, "Let's do it again." I put my finger in his ear and I prayed for him. Sid, instantly God did a recreative miracle and he hears to this day.

Sid: Now what explanation are you going to give me? His whole inner ear was removed and now he can hear normal. God is so wonderful. But Brian mentioned something. He talked about a man that had to forgive God. Why would someone have to forgive God? Because you have judged harshly. You have judged unlimited knowledge. If you had full knowledge, you would not judge against God. And people have to forgive themselves, and people have to forgive others. And when the Holy Spirit reminds you of things of the past, layer after layer, after layer will come off of you. There is such a presence of God on this revelation, as Brian shares. I'm gonna have him teach a little when he comes back. Don't go away.

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Sid: Hello. Sid Roth here with Brian Adams. And Brian, I know most people when they're offended they rehearse it over and over in their mind, and they can't even help themselves. What are they doing as they're rehearsing this?

Brian: What you're doing is, is repetition, you are just repeating or I like to use the word rehearsing. What you're doing is you're building a stronghold. But it's not a godly stronghold. And what God has required us to do is to pull every thought captive into the obedience of Christ Jesus. Meaning, He wants it to be according to the Word. Our thoughts become His thoughts. And what they do, Sid, is it's almost because of a type of pride and someone saying, how dare someone do that to me. But you know what I've seen? I've seen that what we got to do is pull these thoughts captive, make the decision it is God's will. Now all through the Bible this is what we hear. Jesus, when he said, "When you stand praying, if you have an audience with anybody forgive." It will hinder your prayer life. It will keep you from hearing or receiving from God. He even says, when you bring in an offering if you know there's somebody, not only you against them, but someone has something against you, stop and go to them. So we're talking your prayer life, your financial life. Now we see when they tore the roof off the ceiling for a man to get into a meeting that was sold out, so to speak, they lowered him down there. He said, "Your sins be forgiven you." Now all of the people that were there said, who does this guy think he is? Who's Jesus. Only God can forgive sins. But what we learn here is the same spirit that heals is the same spirit that forgives. And if you cannot be forgiven, if you don't forgive, then Sid, you can't be healed. It becomes like a cellblock, which is what the devil wants.

Sid: Wait a second. We are emotional beings. And if I'm walking in the grocery store and I see someone in the next line that has talked against me, and I don't like him too much, I'm gonna walk the other way.

Brian: Yes.

Sid: What do I do? Walk up to him?

Brian: Well I tell you what. John 10:10 says, "The thief comes to still, to kill, and to destroy." What he's actually done is stole that relationship from that fellow believer.

Sid: Right.

Brian: And so what I'm going to do is say I'm making a decision to forgive these people and I'm going to take this friendship back. I'm gonna go walk right up to him and say, "Hi, it's so good to see you."

Sid: Alright. But what if I do that and I still churn a little on the inside?

Brian: You probably will because I have many times, Sid.

Sid: Okay. I'm normal.

Brian: Yes, normal, yes you are. That's a normal reaction. But just like you rehearse the negative, just like you rehearse being hurt, God wants you to rehearse forgiving. See, it might take numerous times. Rather, I always say, repetition is the mother of success. If at first you don't succeed try, try again. I pray and say I make a conscious decision to forgive every person that's ever hurt me. Now when I see him, Sid, if it comes right back up and that knot's there, I say, devil you're a liar. I made a decision to forgive them. You're not coming back to still that. And when he tries to remind you of what happened in the past, just stir him up and remind him of his future, which isn't too good.

Sid: Brian, you teach and it's so marvelous about forgiveness from the cross. Would you teach that.

Brian: Yes. Because just like we were talking just a second ago, we rehearse and we think about it. Someone does us wrong. We retreat to our cave almost like Elijah did when Jezebel said some words against him. Well what he need to do is we learn when Christ was actually on the cross, Sid, here's what he did. While they pulled out his beard, they beat him at the whipping post. Now they're mocking him. They've nailed his hands and his feet. All this is going on. They're screaming. They're rejecting him. The whole world that he come for was rejecting him. He didn't wait until later, but here's what he did. He said right while it's happening, right while it's there, he said, "Father, forgive them. They know not what they're doing." Now there's a key right there, Sid. They know not what they're doing. The humans become a puppet. The devil is the puppet master. That's why Jesus said, "Forgive them. They don't know what they're doing." And that makes it so much easier to make that decision to forgive that these people have been deceived. Because if they knew who he really was they would never do you wrong. You're their eternal relative in the Kingdom of God.

Sid: Well not only that, if they do something to me, they're doing something to Jesus.

Brian: Oh yes.

Sid: I mean, do you realize that when you do something negative to another person and that person knows the Messiah you're doing something negative. But what about if something horrible happens, like someone has been raped by their father, how they can forgive him?

Brian: Well one of the things that the Spirit of God has spoken to me about, Sid, is He said, just take what that person has done and just picture them coming to Jesus and saying, "Jesus, I repent of my sins. Will you forgive me?" Now I know that if you go with a repented heart, he's gonna forgive you. Now you say, well they haven't repented. They haven't asked me. Well here's what happens. You need to, at this time, do it for the sake of Jesus. That he didn't be at the whipping post in vane. You make this decision because you're protecting yourself. It's almost like once you have the armor on, part of the armor on is forgiveness. They said, "They will know we are believers by our love." And part of the fruit of love is forgiveness. How are they ever gonna know that we're for real, Sid?

Sid: Okay. You say that anyone can make a free will conscious decision to forgive and receive their healing.

Brian: Yes. That is true.

Sid: Lead people in a prayer right now for that.

Brian: Jesus, he laid down his life and he died for you. And this is what he wants you to do. He came and he taught Peter, he taught the disciples. He said, "I not only want to forgive you, but I want you to begin to network with Heaven. I want you to become a distributor of the power of forgiveness." And we block things and we hide them in our unconscious. That's why I called this prayer. I'm getting ready to ask you to pray the conscious decision for counting at a cost. Now please remember this right here. I am not saying by you praying this prayer that you are making a statement, they're not guilty. What they did to you is despicable and it was wrong. I agree with you. But we're going to step up into the supernatural realm, the God realm, becoming children of the most high God. He's a forgiver and we should be, too. So I want to help you right now pray this prayer. Just repeat after me. I'm here to help you. I know you can't do it by yourself. But with us, where two or more or gathered together, Sid's right here, there Jesus is. Pray this prayer with me. Say, dear Heavenly Father, I make a conscious decision to forgive every person that's ever hurt me, that's ever done me wrong, that's ever lied against me, that's ever hurt one of my family members. God, if I feel you let me down, I even release and forgive you. I forgive myself for wrong decisions. I release the past and I let it go. I make a decision right now to receive forgiveness from having unforgiveness. I want to be walking close with you again, God. I receive restoration and I receive the power from Heaven that's released when forgiveness is granted. Father, I thank you that you're touching people, and every mental tormenting spirit, every physical pain and every problem must leave now, from fibromyalgia to bursitis and arthritis, mental stress, anxiety, all phobias and fears, your power is broken now in the name of Jesus. These people have now been restored back to the Father. I'm proud of you. It's one of the greatest decisions since accepting Jesus that you've made.

Sid: And one of the things I have found is there has to be a little faith in this transaction.

Brian: Yes.

Sid: That means if you have a pain in your back get up and bend over. A pain in your neck, start moving your head like this. Pain your fingers, start moving your fingers like that. Pain your hip, stand up and jump. This is a moment of a release of the presence, the river of the healing, Anointing of God. I speak peace into your spirit, peace that passes human understanding that sickness cannot rear its ugly head in Jesus' name.
