SID: Hello. Sid Roth here. Welcome to my world where it's natural supernatural. There have been two times in my life where I experienced such an awesome presence of supernatural peace. Let me tell you the two times. First, when I became a believer I dealt with the worst fear a human can have. It was so bad I didn't want to live. And I went to bed, and I said a two-word prayer, "Jesus help." And when I woke up, I woke up, but there was something different. The room was flooded with tangible supernatural peace like I had never experienced in my life. Now I've never been on drugs. I can't tell you what that's like. I've never been an alcoholic. I've never even been drunk. I can't tell you what that's like. But I can tell you that this peace was so awesome it changed everything about me. Then the second time was I come from an orthodox Jewish background and my father was the tough one in my family. I couldn't even say the name "Jesus" without him being so deeply offended and hurt. Well he was dying in intensive care in the hospital. A week before this peace came all over me, tangible. It was wonderful. I didn't even know why it was there, but I liked it. But God knew why it was there. Twenty-four hours a day for seven days I walked in this most amazing peace. And when I went into the hospital room with this peace supernaturally, I tell you, my father did not want to receive Jesus, but he could not resist this supernatural peace. And my orthodox Jewish father, I heard with my own ears, he said, "Jesus is my Messiah." And boy, now I have found out, but here's what I found out. I can walk in this same peace, this same favor, this same presence, this same feeling, 24/7. And my guest is going to teach you how to do this. Dennis Clark, do you walk in this supernatural peace 24/7? Really, between you and me, the honest truth.

DENNIS: Honest truth?

SID: Honest truth.

DENNIS: 24/7. But when I blow it I get back there real fast.

SID: Do you teach others and do they walk in it?

DENNIS: Yes. That's the passion of my life, is when I discovered that it was something that could be duplicated. I just fell in love with it. It's my whole life. It's that little children right up onto adults. They can all learn.

SID: Okay. The Hebrew word for peace is "shalom". But shalom means more than just the English word "peace". What does *shalom* mean?

DENNIS: *Shalom* means wholeness, completeness. It includes prosperity. It includes healing. It includes relationships or friendships emitted by the spirit. It includes everything from a sense of knowing justice, and the part I like, no pain, because God takes that pain away in shalom. In the

peace there's safety. I've seen situations of deliverance and safety, both really, in the shalom of God, tranquility, harmony. Everything is intact.

SID: Listen, doctors would say that if you could rid of stress you'd probably get rid of most of the diseases known to man. Can you actually live a stress-free life?

DENNIS: Yes. Yes you can. And if you're not it's certainly within your reach. It's within every believer's reach to live in it and to practice it. Stress is basically meaning that you're being controlled, this is especially for men, you're being controlled emotionally by people or circumstances, and that it is the opposite of trusting God.

SID: So you have a choice to be controlled by people and circumstances or God, but you can't be by both.

DENNIS: Not both.

SID: Last night at dinner you told me something and you were demonstrating it. It's amazing. Most people hear what someone is saying. But you do what you call dual awareness. Explain that.

DENNIS: Dual awareness is on people's words there's a nature and it's just like the scriptures say, "Let the words of your mouth and the meditations be acceptable." They're both acceptable. And people talk. They can say something pleasant, but the nature that's attached to it can be something unpleasant.

SID: So have your built in lie detector. It's sort of like, well that's the Bible calls discernment.

DENNIS: Yes. It's making a distinction or a differentiation between what is said and what is the nature that's attached to us.

SID: So most of us are talking to someone, like I'm talking to you, and it's mind to mind, but you're dual nature is you know the person by your spirit. Now you talked about dropping down from the mind to the spirit and living in the spirit, which we've been talking about. Tell me the five G's of peace.

DENNIS: The five G's of peace, and you can find them in scripture. It's the direction that really the Holy Spirit wants us all to live our lives. The first one is to govern. In other words, let the peace of God rule. And in that same scripture He also says, let the peace of God be the umpire. Let Him call the shots or let Him guide you, the second G. So there's governing, there's guiding. There's also this wonderful capacity for Him to guard. Let the peace of God guard your heart and your mind through Christ Jesus. To live in that realm is reality. And then from guarding your heart there's even the capacity to gather. It has, just as we talked earlier, it draws. It's like a magnet. People are drawn to true comfort. When it's the comfort or the peace of the Holy Spirit people of all backgrounds, believers and non-believers, are attracted to something that, even if they can't put their finger on it. They're attracted. It gathers. And the last one is that peace grounds. I noticed in the Prince of Peace, in Isaiah, it talked about the "government is upon his

shoulders" and he is ordering it and establishing it. And I like that word "establishing" because then you're getting grounded in it. You're not just kind of there. You're deepening that relationship to where it becomes more permanent by reason of, again, practice.

SID: What happened to you in the halfway house?

DENNIS: This was a supernatural manifestation of peace. We were in an atmosphere that you could tell someone was about to run, because the atmosphere gets charged, and you know someone is going to do something like, I'm leaving this place. And in that atmosphere suddenly it was a little bit of a warning. But all of a sudden this one man pulled a knife out. He had not taken his medication. And I was standing at the only exit, and he was going to go through me. And he pulled that knife on me, and I felt the supernatural peace of God on the inside of me as well as almost a canopy guarding me, making me safe.

SID: But your intellect must have been saying, tilt, I'm getting out of this picture.

DENNIS: Tilt, yes. And that's the power of peace. Peace overrode it, and you basically find out that things go better when God's in charge.

SID: Okay. Did he say what he was going to do to you?

DENNIS: Yeah. He was going to cut me in a little pieces if I didn't get out of the way. I knew that I knew, that I knew I had a deep, rigid peace that I wasn't moving. But it got even better than that. Because it was not just a matter of me being safe and unharmed from him and the security of that peace, but I saw the manifestation of what I believe was Jehovah Shalom, or the God of Peace, the one that crushes the enemy beneath your feet. Because I saw him even without the medication that he failed to take and with the knife in his hand, I saw him soften as I stood there, and soften to where he put the knife down, and he was just like as tender as a little puppy.

SID: Did you catch that? Supernatural protection in this supernatural peace. What about supernatural favor? How would you like some supernatural favor in this supernatural peace? We'll be right back.

SID: Hello. Sid Roth here with Dennis Clark. And Dennis, you're traveling, what was it, 13 and a half hours in a car, it's late at night, you're tired, you're ready to go, you're just a little bit from your hometown. And all of a sudden you see a policeman and police were stopping traffic. Tell me about that.

DENNIS: Thirteen and a half hours in the car, driving, maybe one to four miles from our hotel where we were going to spend the night. This is like 10:00 at night. And all of a sudden, eight lanes of traffic are stopped dead and police are setting up the yellow tape. They're calling it a crime scene. There had been a shootout on the interstate, and they made it a crime scene. They were looking for shell cases. They wanted to see what was going on. And cars were trying to go up the down ramp, and anything to escape it, because they saw this is going to be a long drawn out affair. And Jennifer and I were in the car and we hold each other accountable. And she said, "We're going to practice what we preach and we're just going to get into the presence of God rather than getting up in our head and analyzing the whole situation," which would have been detrimental. And we felt the peace of God, and I felt in the peace of God a slight leaning, which to me would have made no logical sense. I moved over one car length and then up one car length in traffic. And the beautiful part was that in that little, just that one little step of changing lanes by one car length all of a sudden one policeman came, took the yellow tape back and let out a number of cars, of which must have been around eight or nine. And immediately behind me he closed the tape.

SID: So you were the last car he let in.

DENNIS: I was the last car he let in. And as I'm driving down the highway, I must have been excited, because I looked in my rearview mirror and I was passing, there was only the other eight that got out with me. And I'm thinking, the thought happened then and I kind of dismissed it. I said, I believe there was an angel. I believe that was an angelic helper.

SID: It doesn't make sense he'd only let nine cars go through.

DENNIS: Right.

SID: I agree with you. I agree that was angelic help. But how long did the other cars have to stay in that line?

DENNIS: This was 10:00 in the evening. And we read the paper in the morning, which actually described that there was a car chase and a shootout, that it was 6:00 in the morning before they opened those lanes. And we got one good night sleep, a matter of fact, slept even better thinking of that. In hindsight, that it had to be an angel of God, because there was no logical reason other than the peace of God making a way where there was no way.

SID: Listen, I would much rather have been in a hotel bed than the other cars who had to stay in their cars all night long. Did you get that? But you know what? This is so simple to live in God's supernatural peace 24/7, where favor just overtakes you. He teaches this to children. Tell me about the girl that was afraid to go to sleep, the young girl at night.

DENNIS: A little four-year-old having trouble going to sleep at night. She was just afraid of everything. And it was a real struggle for the parents. And we just prayed with her. It's very interesting. We just told her that, Jesus lives in you. And she would put her hands here like this and smile, and she just had a real relationship that that was reality for her. And when we explained to her, that when you go to sleep he is with you, and then she began to start

proclaiming that to everybody else, they'd say, you're going to go to sleep. And she'd go, um-hmm. And she got militant. She'd go, "Um-hmm. Jesus is with me going to sleep with me, and he's not afraid of nothing and neither am I."

SID: So he says, yeah, you can applaud that. So if I'm understanding you right, this supernatural peace has a force, a power connected with it.

DENNIS: Absolutely. It's the power of peace.

SID: What about illness? What about people with terminal illnesses?

DENNIS: Same thing. We've taught people that sometimes, even in a terminal illness, that the torment that they're living with and the fear that they're living with is, to them, worse than the illness. And if we can get them to deal with that it even the peace then sends a message to the rest of the body that facilitates the kind of healing. All of the physical healings we've seen happened as a result of first coming to the place of peace, or what we would say is internal peace is the rule of Christ. And that sends a powerful message to the rest of the physical body.

SID: Tell me about the woman with arthritis.

DENNIS: The woman with arthritis, she was very, very sick. They didn't even know if she was going to live. And she was bitter. She needed to hear the message of forgiveness more than anything. She had unforgiveness toward her mother. And she was elderly but that bitterness was still very intact, very all pervasive. And she had arthritic hands. She forgave her mother from the heart, and her hands, the arthritis left immediately. Right before your very eyes the hands straightened out after she forgave her mother. Who would have connected the two?

SID: When you see a miracle happen, the spirit of God has been telling me that the bones from the neck all the way across all of your arms and your fingers, if you have pain of any kind, your back, especially in the neck now, anywhere, any of the bones, in those areas are being healed, all pain. Dennis, can you feel what I feel? I feel it. I literally feel it leave people. It's leaving them. I'm going to have Dennis instruct you on how to walk in this supernatural peace when we come back. Don't go away.

SID: Hello. Sid Roth here. And I am overwhelmed because I know what's happened in my life when I've walked into supernatural peace, that I can actually walk in this 24/7. Now Dennis, tell me about this Micmac Indian woman.

DENNIS: Yes. This was an exciting little trip that we took with a group of pastors up into the Maritimes. And we stopped at a little home meeting. We had as many pastors as we had pastors in the home meeting. There was like one for each person. Some people were receiving Christ for the first time as a believer. Others were getting filled with the Holy Spirit. And in the midst of this, we had 15 ministers there, in this midst of this, a woman just goes ballistic. She just has a meltdown. She's watching what's taking place. And she said, "I want more Jesus, too, but you don't understand. I would like to have what these people are having. But you don't understand my whole life." And she started talking. And of course then 13 out of the 15 looked over at Jennifer and I and went, "Here's one for you." And we knelt down by the side of her, and this is front of all these people. And she is just emotionally having a meltdown. And I got her to just put her hand on the belly and say, "We're going to let Jesus in you deal with these things that you're crying out to." And I said, "One at a time," because she's hysterical. You have to slow her down. We had to do it one at a time. And probably unlike anyone I had ever ministered to she had more traumatic events. But in less than 20 minutes here's what happened.

SID: You literally showed her how to release the Prince of Peace into that situation.

DENNIS: Yes. The Prince of Peace on the inside was going to move into all of these areas. She had five serious violations. The first one was she was beaten with a belt as a child until it left perfect scars. The second thing that she told us, and now she's crying and then getting peace on one. Then we go to the next one. Then after the belt beating, she went to the fact that she was sexually molested as a child. And it just breaks your heart. And then you watch her go from the hurt of the pain, and it changes to peace. Then she caught on in the middle. She goes, "You know what's going on inside of me when it's happening, don't you?" And I said, yeah. But that worked as a dual witness. It wasn't for me to show off that I know what's going on. What she saw was, if he can tell what's going on in me it's real and it affirms it. It's like a dual witness is what I call it. The third one is she said she had been raped. The fourth one was that she had had several abortions in her life. And we prayed through the hurt and pain, and grief. And the last one, she just started weeping, and I said say it. She could hardly say it. She said, "I saw my own son murdered before my eyes and nothing was ever done about it." And we prayed her through that. And all of these were serious, serious violations of her personhood. And that's why, you know, only God can do the supernatural. But her response was a countless change, smile, joy. But the revelation that came out of her mouth is what really impressed me. She said, "I feel the peace of God surrounding all around me and making me safe. I'm going back to the reservation. I'm going to help people. I'm going to teach people how to do this."

SID: Well we're going to teach you how to do this in just one moment. But the most amazing thing is that when Dennis goes into places like shopping malls, restaurants, the whole atmosphere changes, and what God is doing in Dennis, He wants to do with you. Would you teach them how to move in this.

DENNIS: The first thing is change your focus. And it's like we always call it first, feel, forgive. But in your mind any person or situation in your mind that causes you to lose your peace down here, and sometimes it helps to even put your hand down on the belly area, because you can sense that with the person or situation there's something unruly down there that needs to change. Then you let or allow Christ the forgiver to flow to that and through that until you feel peace.

Not only when you feel peace and it will happen quickly, but then you will know that up here you have the historical record. But down here you have the heavenly record. I want you to close your eyes wherever you're at right now. I want you to put your hand down low. And you're asking the Holy Spirit to search my heart for any disruption, any chaos, anything that needs to be brought back into order, and restore my peace. That first person or situation that comes to mind, allow, let Jesus the forgiver in you, go to that disruption, to that feeling, through that feeling and let him carry it away. So that just like the scripture we quoted, out of your belly is flowing rivers of love and forgiveness, rivers of living water flowing out when it changes to peace. Most of the time that is all you would have to do, 99 percent of the time.

SID: I can tell you, I experience that peace. I say shalom to it.

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SID: Next week on *It's Supernatural*. There is a spirit of delusion that is coming upon the church, and I want you warned, so it doesn't touch you and it doesn't touch your loved ones. That's what we're going to talk about today.

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
