So, they put in a shunt. I say "they", the neurosurgeons,

put in a shunt that drains spinal fluid.

Then, as time passed, the shunt had to have corrections.

It would malfunction. We went back

in and out of the hospital with many emergencies.

And then, about three years into this,

the entire shunt had to be replaced.

It had developed an infection.

Well, in the replacement process,

they had, inadvertently and accidentally,

put the brand new tubing that would drain spinal fluid

right into a massive blood clot that had not shown up on x-Ray.

Sid: So it wouldn't work.

Glenda: Would not work.

They would not really discover this for hours,

and even a couple of days later,

of what a critical mistake had been made.

On a Sunday morning, they rushed him back into surgery,

and that was the morning

that he truly died on the operating table.

Sid: Ron, when you died on the table, what memory do you have

of what happened when you left your body?

Ron: The memory was heaven.

I knew exactly where I was.
