And the Lord has allowed us to have a church and to bring worship and healing, and deliverance to that region.

SID: Let me take you back a little bit, because you're another one that provokes me to jealousy. The devil knew something about you. He tried to knock you out just as a baby.

GRACE: Yes, absolutely.

SID: But when you were three, your mother said you began to speak in supernatural languages. When you were four you started playing the piano. I took piano lessons when I was about six, for about a week, and it was too hard for me, so I gave up. But then at six, how does someone at six years of age have a vision from Heaven?

GRACE: You know what? It's just so wonderful. It's such a beautiful memory because it's like the first thing I remembered that's ingrained in my heart and my spirit forever, and it's just like it was yesterday. So I remember it. I was upstairs in our house, and I saw this picture of the world and I saw music notes like ribbons and they were encircling the earth, and just going around and round, and flying off and just bringing this beautiful ribbon, this beautiful melody. It was almost like embracing the earth with music. And come to find out later I would be a part of carrying God's love around the world through, it's His song, Sid. It's His song. It's His love song.

SID: Tell me how you get these songs. Where do they come from?

GRACE: Well a lot of them just flow out of my personal prayer time. I have a studio in my home and I play the piano. I worship. It's oxygen to me, Sid. It's literally my life force. I breathe worship. I like the saying that says, "When we worship we inhale Heaven." So as much of Heaven as I can get, I'm just going to worship. So they just come through my personal worship times. A lot of them at church prophetically are birthed when we worship that way. And the Holy Spirit just pours out so graciously, and I'm so honored.

SID: One of your songs I really love is called, "River." Tell me about that song.

GRACE: "River," I love "River" because the Lord told me that "River" was going to be like spiritual CPR and it would literally bring hope and life back to the hopeless and the lifeless. And it would bring those refreshing rivers, those healing rivers. And just like our physical body can't go more than three days without water, how much more, Sid, do we need those refreshing, hydrating, living waters. The Bible says, "If you taste and drink of these living waters you will never thirst again." So I know that this song has some powerful, powerful waters.

SID: Hello. Sid Roth here with Grace Williams. Do you feel stuck? Would you like to get out of the trap that you're in? Is there a way to bust out? Grace, you had a dream. Tell me about that.

GRACE: Yes I did, Sid. And I was actually, when I was working on one of my songs, and I dreamed that I was in this huge glass building. I was trying to get out of it. It was like I was kind of frustrated, almost like panicky, and I would try to jump up and leap up, and get out. And I would kind of hear these voices saying, "You can't get out," kind of like naysayers and things that were trying to hinder me back. And I really wanted to get out. And it was like I lifted my hand and I began to worship and look up to the Heavens, and literally I broke through that glass ceiling, and I went up to a new place in the spirit, and a new dimension. And that place was a place of freedom, that place was a place of no hindrance, nothing holding me back. And right now I feel like the Lord is setting someone free in the name of Jesus. I was just seeking shackles break off. I believe it's especially for women right now, that the Lord is setting you free in the name of Jesus. Like you've carried heavy burdens and this heaviness that you've been carrying, and the Lord says, the spirit of the anointing is setting you free. The anointing of the Lord is breaking every yoke of bondage in the name of Jesus. Just receive your freedom right now and step into that new place of freedom right now.

SID: Now speaking of being free, tell me about that military man in Somalia. Now this is a freedom story, trust me.

GRACE: This is a freedom story, Sid. He had served our U.S. military faithfully, been in several deployments, and he had to go through some pretty horrific things, as you can imagine. And he was diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder, and he came back in shambles, just really broken. He was addicted to alcohol. He was on 17 different medications for the panic attacks, anxiety, sleeplessness, I mean, just a plethora of things. And he began to soak to my songs, Sid, and there was such healing that immediately came to his soul, total deliverance, total freedom. And he said, it was so precious in the email, he said, "I feel like I'm a child again and the Lord has literally removed that trauma," that was like embedded in his soul through the power of worship and soaking, and letting the Lord cleanse him, renew him, set him free. It was so, so powerful.

SID: Now when God gave you the song, "Beautiful Place," you had a vision. You were encapsulated, like in a bubble.

GRACE: Yes. And it was so beautiful, which is just really cool, because the name of the song is "Beautiful Place." But it was this gigantic bubble. And it reminded me of like when you were a kid and you played with bubbles. It was that same, iridescent, almost glowing, almost colorized when you would look at it certain ways. And I just looked all around, and I was like, wow, this is so, so cool. And I felt so protected and so safe. And it was like I would see things going on around me, but they didn't touch me, Sid. It was just like in His presence, in that secret place when we enter into that secret place of worship, there is our Divine protection. There is our safety. It's like in the shadow of His wings He protects us and covers us.
